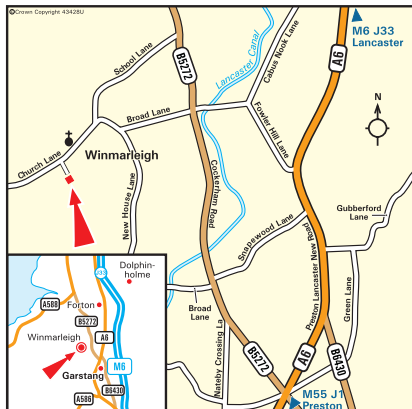

Site and Location

- A 19th Century country House set in 50 acres of gardens, parkland and woodland with a large, purpose-built lake
- All activities take place on-site
- The southern Lake District is an hour away and provides a playground for walkers, canoeists, mountain bikers and climbers
- Approximately 15 miles from the bright lights of Blackpool

Getting There

By bus/coach or train: The nearest stations are in Lancaster; please call the centre on your arrival at the station and they will arrange for someone to collect you.

From the north

- Leave M6 at junction 33 - follow A6 south towards Garstang
- After "The Crofters Hotel" at Garstang, turn right at the traffic lights on to B5272 towards Cockerham
- Follow this road for 1.4 miles. There is a hump-backed bridge over the canal after about 0.75 miles that requires extreme care
- At Mitchell Bros. garage turn left into Broad Lane
- Follow this road through Winmarleigh Village for 0.8 miles; you will pass a church on the right (after 0.6 miles)
- About 300 yards further on is the entrance to Winmarleigh Hall (on the left)

From the south

- Leave M6 at junction 32 on to M55
- Leave M55 immediately at junction 1
- Follow A6 north towards Garstang
- By-pass Garstang on the A6
- You will pass the "The Bellflower" pub on the left hand side
- At the next set of traffic lights - turn left onto B5272 towards Cockerham
- Follow this road for 1.4 miles. There is a hump-backed bridge over the canal after about 0.75 miles that requires extreme care
- At Mitchell Bros. garage turn left into Broad Lane
- Follow this road through Winmarleigh Village for 0.8 miles. You will pass a church on the right (after 0.6 miles)
- About 300 yards further on is the entrance to Winmarleigh Hall (on the left)

Amenities

- Staff room with TV and DVD player, including Freeview and pool table
- Free Wi-Fi access in the communal areas of the main house. All electronic brought at own risk
- Local pub within walking distance
- Garstang; the local town, has a range of pubs, shops and a leisure centre with swimming facilities
- Laundry facilities

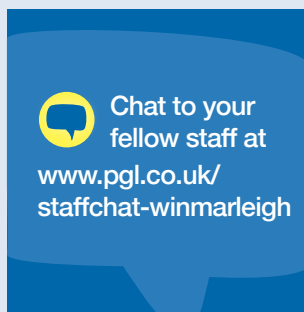


Where You Stay
